

SHOES - If you haven't bought *shoes* yet, don't delay! The following local stores carry many of our recommended shoes: Michelson's in Lexington Center, Patterson's (781-273-3089) in Burlington, Dancer's Image (617-964-4070) in Newton, and Dance This Way (978-318-1960) in West Concord. In addition, you can purchase shoes online at discountdance.com (1-800-328-7107). A small assortment of used shoes is available at The Dance Inn. If you have used dance shoes you would like to sell, drop them off during the morning camp hours, 9:00 – 12:00. Label each shoe with masking tape on the bottom with your name, phone number, the size if known, and the price you are asking and bring a stamped, self-addressed envelope for each pair. We cannot provide envelopes or postage. If you would like to donate used dance shoes please let us know. All proceeds from used donated shoes goes to our Legacy Dancers holiday show. **Used shoes** will be on sale at the studio starting July 21. The studio is open from 9:00 – 12:00, Monday thru Friday July 9-August 8. Office hours will be limited until August 25th when we resume our daily morning hours.

***Tap Shoes** for grades grades 3+ should have full soles—not soft and flexible. **Tap shoes need to fit properly - please don't buy them too big. If they are too big, we will ask you to return them – big shoes interrupt the lesson because they fall off and prevent young tappers from experiencing success!!!!**
